Planning your trip to Rottnest Island

The pre-conference visit to Rottnest Island is an opportunity to relax before the main conference and to explore the delights of this iconic destination. The technical site visit on Sunday morning is included in the full conference registration (see registration form), however delegates and guests can plan the rest of their weekend to suit, including transfers, accommodation and island tours.

REGISTRATION

- Separate registration is not required for the Rottnest Island visit.
- Those planning to attend the site visit on Sunday 20th should indicate this on their main registration form.
- The cost of the facilities site visit is included in full delegate registration.
- All other arrangements are made by the delegate as described below.

GETTING THERE

- While ferry tickets can be purchased on the day, it is a good idea to prebook your return ferry trip.
- Contact Rottnest Express <u>www.rottnestexpress.com.au</u> to make a booking.
- A 30% discount applies for online bookings (**promo code ANZSOM17**). This offer is valid for ferries running from 11th to 31st August 2017.
- Ferries depart daily from Shed B Fremantle at 7.15am, 9.45am or 3.00pm.
- If you plan to just attend the site visit on Sunday 20th, you will need to catch the 7.15am ferry from Fremantle.
- Ferries depart Rottnest Island for the return trip at 8.25am, 2.10pm and 4.25pm. The 4.25pm ferry will get you back in time for the Welcome Reception. Those attending the General Council meeting on Sunday afternoon will need to catch the 2.10pm ferry.

ACCOMMODATION

- The Rottnest Island Authority has a variety of accommodation options ranging from basic to premium, some with breathtaking ocean views and others with unique heritage features.
- Most accommodation on Rottnest Island is available for a minimum of 2 nights and is booked through the Rottnest Island Authority.  - o The Desalination plant
 - o The Wind Mill and the new Solar Panel Farm
 - o Sewerage Treatment Plant.
 - o Management of the rubbish and recycling
