CONDUCT AUDIOMETRY, PERFORM OTOSCOPY AND MANAGE HEARING TESTS

This 1-day workshop provides efficient, hands-on training for small groups in the basic skills required to conduct hearing tests on adults, primarily within general practice and health assessment organisations.

During the workshop, students will learn how to conduct audiometry, perform otoscopy and manage the numerous elements that can affect the accuracy of hearing test results.

Conducting a hearing test looks simple enough but there is more going on than meets the eye. Research reveals that formal training produces accuracy, competence and confidence in practitioners enhancing the quality and reputation of the service provider.

The course combines theory and practical training in a compact format, utilising a range of teaching methods and materials including:

- Informative lectures
- Practical workbook exercises
- Industry examples from experienced testers
- Demonstrations and role plays
- Hands-on practice session (audiometry and otoscopy)

At the completion of this workshop students will have achieved a basic understanding of the skills and knowledge required to be an audiometric tester with confidence in applying the skills in the workplace.
