To apply or renew Corporate Group Membership

To apply:

1. Nominate a main organisation representative who will be responsible for all correspondences.
2. Complete the forms as follows:
 - **Form A – New Corporate Group Member Application:** Include a list of all employees to be covered in the membership.
 - **Form B – Individual Application Form(s):** Provide a completed form for each non-member/new employee attaching CVs and obtaining signatures of nominator and seconder for each non-member/new member (and for those who are not current financial members).
 - **Form D – Payment Form:** Complete the Payment Form, and return all paperwork (including individual application forms) to the Secretariat for processing.

To renew:

1. Renewal forms are sent to the nominated organisation representative to complete during February/March of the new subscription year.
2. Complete the forms as follows:
 - **Form C – Corporate Group Renewal Form:** Check and confirm employees who are renewing their membership. Include a list of any new employees to be covered in the membership.
 - **Form B – Individual Application Form(s):** Provide a completed form for each non-member/new employee attaching CVs and obtaining signatures of nominator and seconder for each non-member/new member (and for those who are not current financial members).
 - **Form D – Payment Form:** Complete the Payment Form, and return all paperwork (including individual application forms) to the Secretariat for processing.

A letter confirming membership and receipt of payment will be sent to the organisation representative once the membership is processed. Individual acknowledgement and member certificates will also be sent to those nominated for your group membership.
