MEMBER TYPES & FEE CATEGORIES

Main membership types:

- **Full Member** – Full membership is open to health professionals engaged in or interested in occupational medicine and with a qualification entitling them to be registered as a medical practitioner or nurse. Discounted fees are available for AFOEM Trainees.
- **Associate Member** – Associate membership is open to those engaged in or interested in occupational health and medicine but *do not* have qualifications as a registered medical practitioner or nurse.

Discounted memberships available:

- **Full member (AFOEM Trainees)** – A discounted membership fee applies for those undergoing specialty training in occupational and environmental medicine. AFOEM trainees are Full members of ANZSOM and receive the same member benefits.
- **Corporate Group Membership** – Discounted membership fees of up to 10% are available to organisations with at least 5 employees wishing to become Full or Associate members (including current members).
- **Retired (non-practising) member** – We encourage Full or Associate members of ANZSOM who have retired from practice to continue to be involved in the organisation. A special fee (50% off) for retired members is now available.
