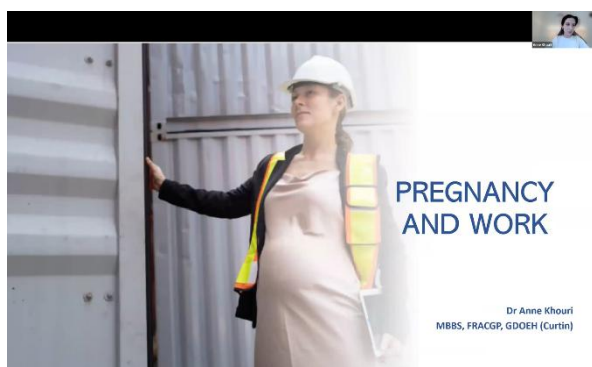

# ANZSOM WEBINAR SERIES 2026

The 2026 webinar schedule has been created to showcase a wide variety of topics, catering to the diversity of our membership.

## #itswhatyouknow WEBINAR SERIES

ANZSOM offers a regular series of webinars which are run throughout the year. These are targeted to a broad audience and address a diverse range of occupational health topics. Our core series includes 5 webinars with additional offerings as opportunities arise.

Topics **this year** include (subject to change):

- New technologies for management of Type 1 Diabetes – application in an occupational setting
- Cardiometabolic assessments and its importance in occupational settings
- Cardiometabolic syndrome – Occupational impact and its management
- ADHD and modern occupational focuses – a psychiatrist approach
- Epilepsy – the new frontiers

## Nurses Focus webinars (3 per year)

This series is designed specifically for occupational health nurses and aligns with the [OHN Competency Standards](#). Our plans for this year are well underway. Last years' topics included:

- Unlocking the potential of early intervention in work injury management
- Assessing and managing pregnancy risk in the workplace
- Leveraging the law to promote a healthy psychosocial workplace

## Occupational Medicine 101 series (3 per year)

This series is designed to connect attendees with the fundamental concepts of occupational health and enable direct engagement with some of the leading experts in the field. While ideally suited to trainees, professionals of all levels find this a beneficial format for exploring and sharing the essentials of occupational health.

Last years' topics included:

- Applied risk management: Frameworks, methodologies and practice
- Planning and preparing for a work site visit
- DAMP 101: Drug and alcohol management plans
